Personal Reflection

Take time this week to pray & reflect on the following:

God's faithfulness to you is unmatched. No one loves you more than Him and no one is more invested in securing your well-being for all of eternity. The life, ministry and saving work of Christ is the supreme evidence of God's love and devotion to His Church.

God expects you to follow His example of faithfulness. His indwelling Holy Spirit empowers you to bear fruit through faithful obedience and service. Followers of Christ are expected to be faith-filled men and women who keep their word, who are worthy of trust and who are dedicated to the unity, peace and maturing of the Church. Faithfulness brings blessing and enables one to be a blessing to others. It binds together the family of God and draws in those who are ready to receive Christ.

Are you perhaps overly-focused on other people's duty to you while being too-little focused on your duty to God and to others as His ambassador of love? Is your faithfulness to God evident in how you use your time, spend your money, conduct your affairs and plan for the future?

Prayerfully, assess the condition of your faithfulness. If it is inconsistent or erratic, ask God for the will and strength to change. If you are faithfully following your Savior, commit to continue and ask God to reveal ways in which you can help others do the same. Give praise and thanksgiving to God for His unfailing love and perfect example of faithfulness.
